Internet browsers and Oracle will be deprecating the Java browser plugin. In response to this, Mediaocean is changing its applet options from Java plugins to Java applications.

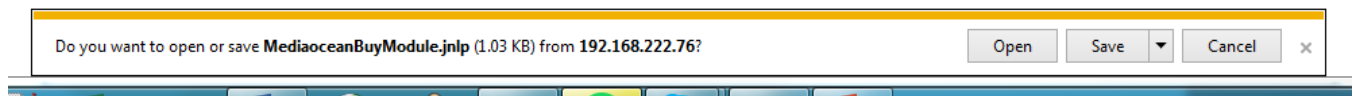
The options affected are outlined in the table below.

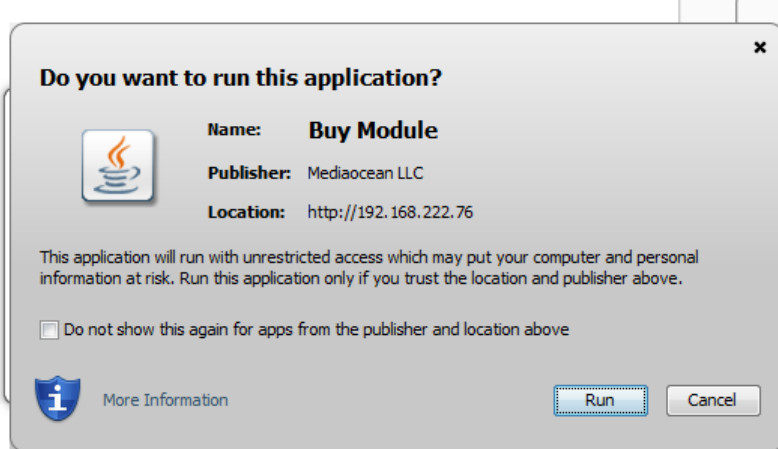
What the agencies need to do for PCs

When the Java application replaces the applet, you'll see two messages after **opening Vendor Charge Entry** or **AP Recurring Payments**.

1. The first message displays at the bottom of the page. Click **Open**.



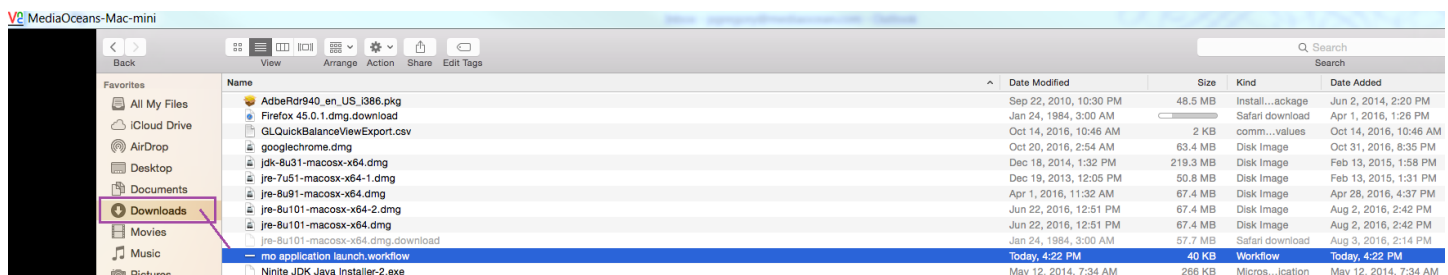
2. The second message displays each time you change session. Changing session means logging off or changing to different system (Financials to Production or Media Accounting to CDB, etc.). Click **Run**.



What the agencies need to do for MACs

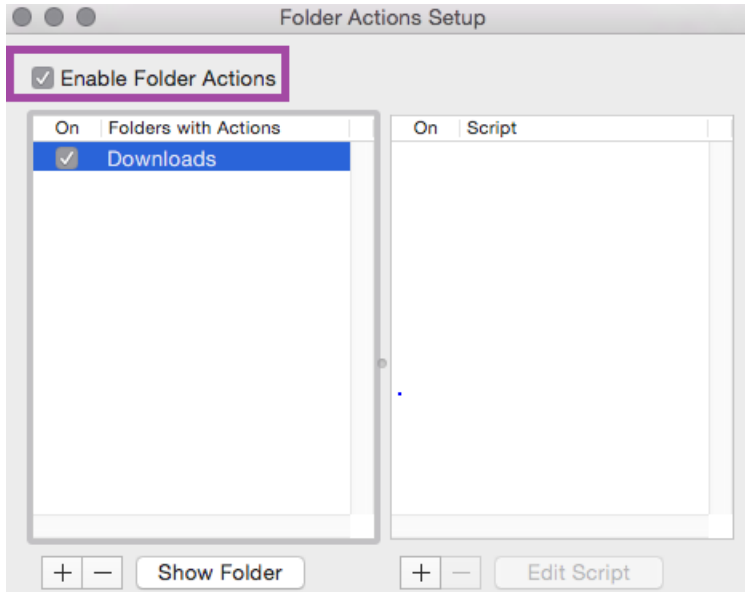
Download the necessary file [here](#).

Click on the attachment to send it to Downloads. The file gets unzipped automatically. If your settings designate a different folder for the “mo application launch.workflow” file, then it needs to be moved to the Downloads folder.



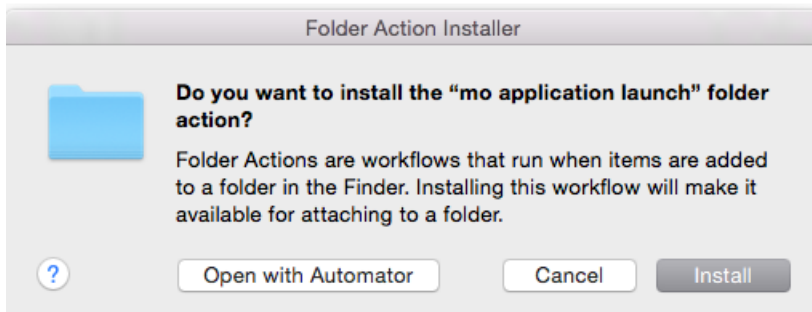
To verify that the Launch script will attach correctly in the Folder Action Setup, confirm that the “Enable Folder Actions” setting has been checked:

1. Right-click the Downloads folder.
2. Depending on the version of OS X being used, this setting may be under : 'Folder Action Setup' (which also may be located under the Services menu item.) It may also be listed under the 'More' item if you have quite a few contextual menu items installed. Ultimately, this box should be checked:



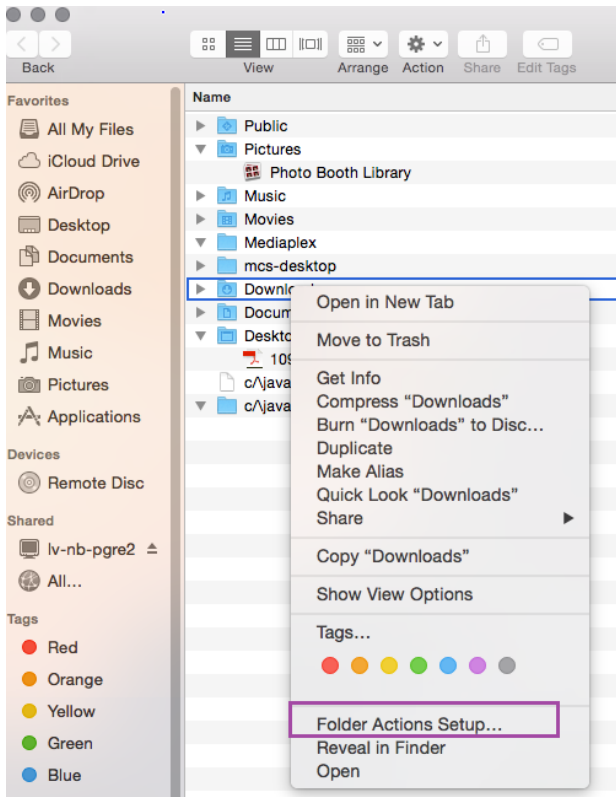

Go to the Downloads folder and double click on the file that was unzipped. The Folder Action Installer is displayed.

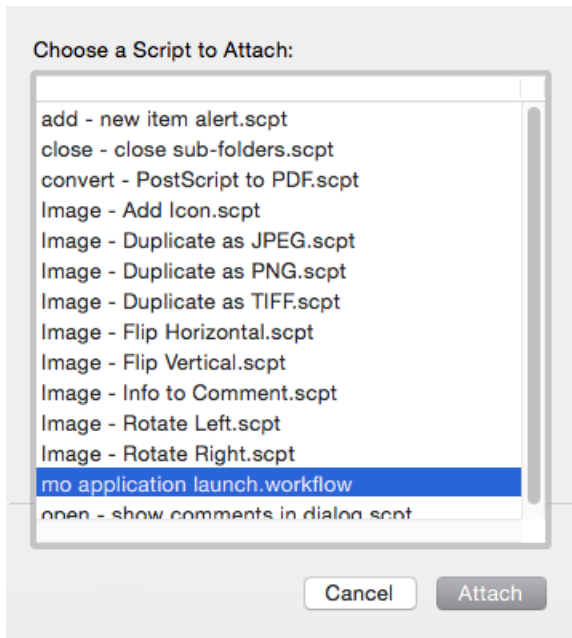


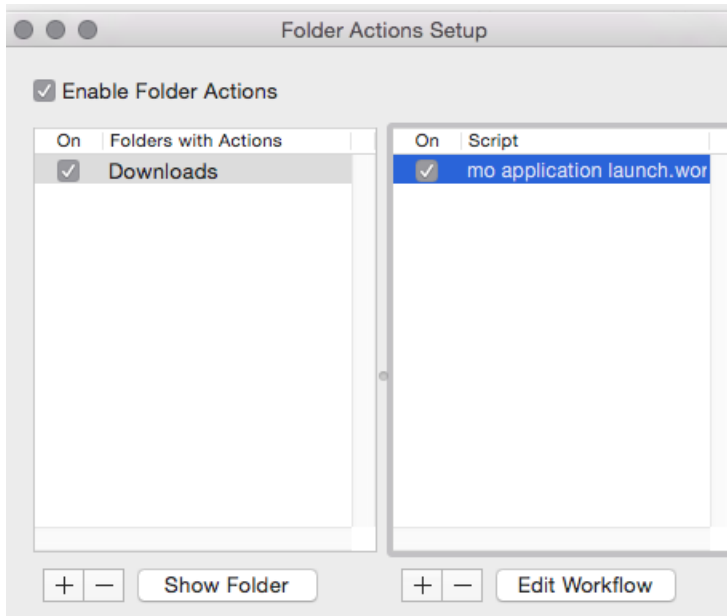
Click on Install. If on Yosemite, the Installer may send a “failed” message, but it does not fail. Click Done. If on El Capitan, the installer gives user info on where the installer placed the Action Folder just installed. Make sure the Action Folder get attached to the Folder that will receive the Mediaocean jnlp files.

Go to Finder/Go/Home. Right Click on Downloads and choose:



Choose the Mediaocean Application Launch folder and click Attach.





The Action Folder is attached now and ready to launch Mediaocean jnlp files.
